500th Anniversary of the Reformation Commemorated on Family Radio

The Just Shall Live By Faith

Romans 1:17

October 31, 2017, marks the 500th anniversary of the Reformation, a call for change and examination as we're told in II Corinthians 13:5.

Five hundred years ago, Martin Luther was concerned with the religious climate of his day – particularly, the selling of "indulgences," which were certificates of absolution for past sins.



Committed to God's Word and that salvation could be reached through faith, divine grace, and adhering to the Scriptures, Luther vigorously objected to the corrupt practice of selling indulgences. Acting on this belief, he wrote the "Disputation on the Power and Efficacy of Indulgences," also known as "The 95 Theses," a list of questions and propositions for debate. Popular legend has it that on October 31, 1517, Luther nailed a copy of his 95 theses to the door of the Wittenberg Castle church in Germany, making it public for all to see. Although these events changed the course of history for Christians, Luther's intent was to start a dialog, not a revolution. Yet, the advent of the printing press helped spread the news even further throughout Europe – and in particular, within Germany – causing information to be made available to the public in ways that had never been seen before the sixteenth century.

Family Radio will be airing a series of specials highlighting the 500th anniversary of the Reformation with various features and guest speakers discussing the historical background that led up to the Reformation and the advancement of the Gospel in our world today.
