WFME - Celebrating 50 Years of Ministry

Where Faith Means Everything

Fifty years ago, in 1966, Family Radio officially became the owners of radio station WJRZ-FM, in the New York/Northern New Jersey area. They went on the air 24-hours-a-day, and changed the call letters to WFME, which stands for: **W**here **F**aith **M**eans **E**verything!

Prior to that, the ministry had been purchasing segments of time on the station, first being heard in the area on Easter Sunday, April 14, 1963.

Charlie Menut, WFME's current station and regional manager, recalls: "I came on board in September of 1981. Family Radio had already been on the air for 22 years. To me, that was mind-boggling, because most stations don't really last that long - and if they do, formats change. Technically, radio was quite simple back then. You didn't have computers or satellites. As long as you knew how to use a turntable and a cart machine, you were in pretty good shape! As an engineer, that was my job when I first came to WFME. But, these days, it's just so important to keep up with constantly advancing technology!"

Years later, more changes were in store for the station. Family Radio's programming on 94.7 FM ended on January 11, 2013. Prior to signing off of the frequency, Charlie Menut stated that the network's programming would be transferred to 106.3 FM, from Mt. Kisco, NY; this became the new WFME-FM, which began broadcasting four days later on January 15th.

Because many people in the greater New York City area could no longer receive the signal, a search ensued by Family Radio's management for a replacement station to complement its FM signal from Mt. Kisco. This effort came to a glorious conclusion in 2015 with the purchase of WQEW 1560 AM. Then, on February 27, 2015, at 12:00 noon (Eastern), Family Radio was once again being heard throughout the area, restoring much of the signal that had been lost, but now is on the AM dial complementing its Mt. Kisco, NY, FM signal.

Can I Trust in the LORD With All My Heart? Part 1

"Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths." Proverbs 3:5&6

How does one cease from trusting one's own thinking and come to trust God?

What does it take for us to trust God sufficiently enough to not lean upon our own understanding?

What does it take for us to lean upon Him and trust Him in every situation, no matter how perilous?

The answer is faith!

At root, trust in the LORD is the same as having faith in the LORD.

The faith God speaks of as being sufficient for us to please Him is a unique kind of faith:

A kind of faith that carries us beyond our own human limitations and fears.

A kind of faith beyond our own natural faith, to where we trust God with our very lives.

Most importantly, the kind of faith sufficient for us to stop working the works we think will please God; rather, to a faith in the all-sufficient work of Jesus Christ - the "author and finisher of *our* faith" (Hebrews 12:2).

Where does this faith which pleases God come from?

"But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him." Hebrews 11:6

Only one true faith: There are many kinds of faith in this world, but only one true faith is sufficient to please God:

In **Galatians 2:16,** God describes what and Whose faith is needed for us to be justified and pleasing to Him:

"Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ that we be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified."

Those who are "justified, are justified only by the faith of Jesus Christ."

In our next issue, we will see that Christ Jesus possesses a very distinct and unique faith, a faith that is delivered to His people.
