Our Lord is using Family Radio in extraordinary ways for a powerful ministry — reaching behind the barbed wire fences and thick concrete walls of our prisons, blessing men and women behind bars with His Word!

Inmates from all over the country write to us daily, telling how they are so thankful to God for Family Radio. The radio programs and printed materials they receive from us are in many cases, like a "lifeline," as their only connection with God's Holy Word, the Bible.

Some write to say that they've learned about God's salvation through Christ Jesus while they were in prison. Others tell how they want to be used of the Lord as His witnesses to fellow inmates, as they seek to repent, and honor God. But the strongest cry from them is asking for our prayers.

There are those who are serving a light sentence, or are at the end of their long sentence, and will be out soon. They ask for prayer for their family and friends to receive them with open arms as they return to society. They also ask that we pray that God would help them to truly change their ways - to keep them on His path for their lives.

Then there are those inmates who write, telling us that they will be in prison for a long, long time - some, even on "Death Row." They also are asking us for prayer — prayer that they will uphold their faith, knowing that even though they are behind bars, in Christ they are set free!

Your prayers and support to Family Radio are being used so wonderfully — including, changing hearts and lives and ministering to people behind prison walls. Lord, Teach Us to Pray A STUDY BY HAROLD CAMPING

The Lord's prayer is given to us in the Word of God in two passages, Luke 11:2-4 and Matthew 6:9-13:

After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come.

Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil:

For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

Day by Day

In Luke, God says, "day by day," and when we tie this passage together with the phrase in Matthew 6:11, "Give us this day our daily bread," we get this picture: "Give us Christ day by day, on a continuing basis, that we might have bread for the morrow," from moment to moment.

What is the bread that the Bible talks about?

Jesus says in John 6:35, "I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst." He says in John 6:51, "I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world."

When we pray, "Give us this day our daily bread," effectively we are saying to God, "O God, give us the Lord Jesus Christ that we might be in Him, spiritually nourished and strengthened, so that we can walk day to day, moment to moment. Whatever the future holds, He is sufficient for us."

"And Forgive Us Our Debts"

At least three words are commonly used in the New Testament to signify "sin," including the word "debt."

We are debtors to God because we have sinned. The Bible says, "For the wages of sin is death" (Romans 6:23). There is a penalty that we must pay to God for our sins, and that payment is eternal destruction. When we pray, "forgive us our debts," effectively, we are praying, "O God, have mercy on me. I'm a sinner. Will you pay the penalty that I rightly deserve to pay?" The Lord Jesus came to demonstrate how He endured that payment on our behalf from the foundation of the world. He demonstrated how He ransomed His elect from the power of the grave.
