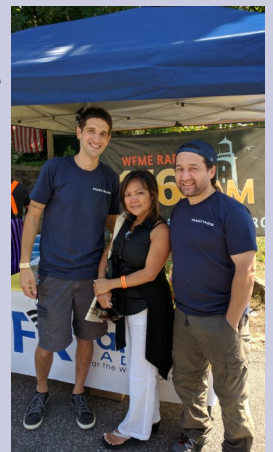


### WFME at the Fair

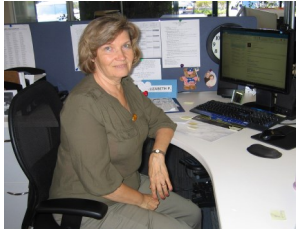

### Finding Strength



Elizabeth Petushkov serves as a member of our Information Technology (IT) team, supporting other staff members with their computer and data programming needs. Elizabeth was not originally trained to be an IT technician. In her native country of Latvia, she studied biology before coming to the U.S. She and her family had endured persecution

throughout her life, growing up as declared Christians in a totalitarian state. Then the door opened for them to move to America. Upon her arrival, the Lord had plans for her outside of biology. She shares her impressions:

“Under pressure, your Christianity shines! In this country, it is so difficult to hold myself and please the Lord because there is so much temptation. I found that I have to be careful how I walk, what I read, what I see - a different kind of circumstance here, where God placed me. I believe that a lot of Christians can relax and drift away, little by little, from the Lord. That’s a danger of this world.

When it was time for immigration, I prayed: “Heavenly Father, I would like to be Your witness. I do not need to be rich; nor, do not make me to be very poor. I would like to always have a job.” And that was fulfilled. But my goal was not having a job or living in prosperity. I wanted to be God’s witness because Christ came to build the kingdom of God here, and it is in us. And I wanted to invite everybody to this kingdom, and ask people to be reconciled to God and to come to Him because we are His children. He has prepared a treasure for us. There are people holding Bibles and begging for money. Open it! Because there are so many promises inside. Just know the Lord. Desire His Presence, not His gifts. His Presence is the key to a successful Christian life. Repent! Don’t be proud.

Also, when I first came to this country, I wanted to go into the medical field. But God closed all the avenues for me. Instead, He put me in the Data Processing Department at Family Radio. I didn’t know computers, and I didn’t like machines - I liked working with people. I prayed, “God, you created me. You know my ability better than I do. Maybe it’s the best for me. I didn’t understand. And as it turned out, I really like my job! I like the people with whom I work. I like to serve. So, with my serving heart, I have been given the ability to fulfil my work - by the grace of the Lord - and I serve as I can.

When I look back, it is so wonderful because I see God’s steps and His Hand in my life. I am very thankful that I know God, His Word, and where to turn for strength and trust, because His Word stands forever! There are many things that I can be thankful to Him for. One thing I’m very thankful for is that Family Radio is still on the air. People can hear the Word of the Lord and find strength through it.”
