Edmund Sears was a pastor for seven years before suffering a mental and emotional breakdown. Beyond the stress of being a pastor, he was burdened by the events of the Mexican– American War that had just ended. At the same time, he was hearing rumors of violent revolution in Europe, and strife in the US foreshadowed civil war.

Sears lived in a turbulent time when peace seemed all but impossible. Amid such chaos, he remembered the angels on Christmas night, proclaiming "peace on the earth, goodwill to men."

So he wrote a poem to remind the world of the call for peace. Today we sing "It Came upon the Midnight Clear" knowing that Jesus is the one true source of peace.
