



Your support of Family Radio provides the hope of Jesus Christ to those who need it most. Here is a story from a listener about how you made a difference in his life!

At age 67, my wife was diagnosed with Primary Progressive Aphasia. In 2016, several times health care professionals told me that it was not possible for me to keep her at home and care for her by myself. So, several times I looked into putting her in a home. But in every case the still small voice within me said "You can care for her, and I will help". And so, as He promised the help began. I was changed overnight, and was given the ability to do something I never imagined, taking care of my beautiful wife as she became like a small child. Every morning when she would awake, I would give her a kiss and tell her I loved her, and she would look at me and smile, and I knew all was well and caring for her was a blessing and not a hardship.

In the first week in February 2019, the Hospice nurse upon leaving told me that she would not make it thru the weekend. I went to her bed side, leaned over and kissed her and said, "Jesus is coming soon to take you home". As I stood there, she turned her head towards me and her face began to glow, the sparkle was back in her eyes, and she had this wonderful expression of childlike excitement of hearing good news. Within 3 days, she was gone.

As you would expect grief came rushing in and I felt the powers of darkness attacking me. I had been through the death of my parents, brother and sister, but I was not prepared for the grief that comes when my wife was called home. As someone told me with great love comes great grief. It was during this time that I began listening to Family Radio and found refuge in the music and messages. So, 18 months later I can finally talk about her without breaking down in tears.
